



**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN SOUTHWESTERN OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY
AND ROSE STATE COLLEGE**

**Associate in Applied Science in Nursing (RSC)
and
Bachelor of Science in Nursing (SWOSU)**

OVERVIEW:

This formal program articulation agreement is made and entered into by Southwestern Oklahoma State University, hereinafter referred to as SWOSU, and Rose State College, hereinafter referred to as RSC. By this agreement SWOSU and RSC express a shared commitment to increasing opportunities for student access to and success in higher education. By clarifying transfer policies and procedures, which assure articulation between programs, the institutions seek to assist students in making a seamless transfer from the associate to the baccalaureate degree.

PURPOSE:

This agreement provides students who have earned an Associate in Applied Science in Nursing at RSC the opportunity to complete a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (R.N. to B.S.N.) at SWOSU. Any RSC student who has earned an Associate in Applied Science in Nursing and adheres to the guidelines within this agreement is guaranteed that SWOSU will accept the A.A.S. in Nursing degree as fulfillment of 30-31 division nursing course credits required for the B.S.N. degree. This agreement also allows a RSC Associate in Applied Science in Nursing graduate to enter the R.N. to B.S.N. program with one credit hour in Microbiology waived.

CONDITIONS OF TRANSFER:

Section I: Admissions and Matriculation

RSC students maintaining continuous enrollment under this agreement will be afforded the same treatment and protection as SWOSU students enrolled under the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree completion program (R.N. to B.S.N.).

Criteria for acceptance into SWOSU will be the same for transfer as for native students.

RSC, upon request of students, will provide verification of completed courses to SWOSU through its Office of Admissions and Records. The transcript of students transferring from RSC will be evaluated by the Registrar's office at SWOSU.

Transfer students from RSC will have access to financial aid, scholarships, and student services on the same basis as native students.

Minimum grade of "C" in all courses must be maintained and retention GPA of 2.50 (on a 4.0 scale) for all previous college/university work and be eligible to take the NCLEX to qualify for transfer under this articulation agreement.

SWOSU will apply the same academic progress and graduation standards to RSC transfer students as those applicable to native students at SWOSU.

Section II: Transfer of Credit

30-31 articulation credit hours of nursing courses will be granted with completion of an Associate in Applied Science in Nursing from RSC and will be applied toward the Bachelor of Science in Nursing at SWOSU. Additionally, the articulation credit hours will satisfy 30-31 of the 60 required hours from a 4 year institution. RSC students will be required to have completed 40 hours of 3000 – 4000 level credit and at least 30 credit hours at SWOSU upon graduation.

Transfer students from RSC, upon acceptance into the R.N. to B.S.N. program at SWOSU, will have junior standing at SWOSU.


TERMS OF AGREEMENT:




