ARTICULATION AGREEMENT SOUTHWESTERN OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY AND ROSE STATE COLLEGE

Rose State College Division of Engineering & Science Chemistry Associate in Science Program and

Southwestern Oklahoma State University College of Pharmacy Doctor of Pharmacy Program

OVERVIEW

This formal program articulation agreement is made and entered into by Southwestern Oklahoma State University, hereinafter referred to as SWOSU, and Rose State College, hereinafter referred to as RSC. By this agreement SWOSU and RSC express a shared commitment to increasing opportunities for student admission to the SWOSU College of Pharmacy Doctor of Pharmacy program.

PURPOSE AND INTENT

This agreement provides for the guaranteed admission of five (5) students enrolled in the Associate of Science in Chemistry program at RSC to the SWOSU Doctor of Pharmacy program. The five (5) student admission guarantee is applicable to both the Fall and Spring admission cycles (a total of ten (10) students in a calendar year). All RSC students admitted to SWOSU and the Doctor of Pharmacy program will be afforded the same rights, privileges, and services provided to any other student admitted from another institution. Transfer students from RSC will have junior undergraduate standing at SWOSU for the first professional year of the SWOSU Doctor of Pharmacy program. Upon successful completion of the first professional year, the student will have professional graduate status.

Guaranteed admission is contingent on the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

- 1. The RSC student will complete the required applications for (1) admission as a transfer student to SWOSU and (2) admission to the SWOSU Doctor of Pharmacy program.
- 2. By the time of matriculation, the RSC student admitted to the SWOSU Doctor of Pharmacy will have successfully completed the coursework in the RSC Chemistry Associate in Science curriculum which crosslists as equivalent with the SWOSU College of Pharmacy pre-pharmacy course requirements (see Appendix) with a grade of C or better. Equivalent courses will be determined by agreement between the RSC Division of Engineering & Science and the SWOSU College of Pharmacy.
- 3. Students will submit official transcripts to SWOSU from all colleges or universities attended. The transcript(s) of RSC students considered for admission to the Doctor of Pharmacy program will be evaluated by (1) the SWOSU Offices of Admission and Academic Records (to verify requirements for transfer admission to SWOSU) and (2) the SWOSU College of Pharmacy Admission Counselor (to verify successful completion of SWOSU College of Pharmacy pre-pharmacy course requirements with a grade of C or better.
- 4. At the time of application to the SWOSU Doctor of Pharmacy program, the student will have at least a 2.50 Overall GPA based on all coursework.
- 5. The student will have no Code of Conduct violations on campus or in the community.
- 6. The student will complete a successful in-person interview with the SWOSU College of Pharmacy.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into immediately and remains in force unless changed in writing by mutual agreement of both parties. The agreement may be amended at any time with the approval of both parties and is subject to regular review to assure currency with the respective degree requirements. Should either party desire to discontinue this agreement, advance notification of two years will be required.
