



Transfer Agreement

Rose State College: A.A. – Political Science
University of Central Oklahoma: B.A. – Political Science

To comply with this agreement, students must complete the associate's degree with the major listed above and include the specific courses listed below.

Courses listed here are required for the agreement. Credited courses completed as part of the A.A. or A.S. that do not apply to the general education at RSC or the UCO major transfer to UCO as electives.

This degree requires additional course work, including the general education as stated in the RSC Catalog. Other RSC courses may or may not apply to the UCO major. That specific information can be found on the UCO website under the Online Transfer Guide.

(May be taken at RSC). This signifies that a UCO course requirement can be met with the equivalent RSC course (found on the UCO website). To take this course at RSC, the student must confirm that it will fit into the associate's degree without exceeding the requirements. A minimum of 60 hours must be taken at a baccalaureate granting institution. Exceeding 64 credit hours at the community college means the student will be required to take more than the minimum of 124 credit hour total. A minimum of 40 hours of 3/4000 level courses are required for the baccalaureate. Courses at community colleges are 1/2000 level.

Modern Language Requirement.....0-8 credit hours

All students completing a B.A. in Political Science shall complete the first two semesters of a second language. Students may alternatively fulfill the language requirement by proof of academic work in the second language (CLEP test through LANG1224), four years of high school language courses, or transfer work from another institution.
